4. Do I notice any resistance in my heart or will to the idea of serving in my parish? If so, have I taken the time to pinpoint the cause of this resistance?
5. From my perspective, what does it mean to be an active member in my parish?
6. What needs do I notice in my parish? Do I look at these needs from a distance, or do I actively find a way to help?
7. Are there types of service that I consider to be beneath my status?
8. If I could choose an area of expertise which I could offer the Church to help her fulfill her mission, what would it be?
