Monday Sept 19 2022: Depart from DC to Tel Aviv

Day 1, Tues, Sept 20- - SAMARIA & NORTHERN ISRAEL

Upon being Greeted by VIP Service to whisk you through security at Ben Gurion airport, Tel Aviv, we will be on our way! **Stop 1: Joppa-** the ancient Port City of Jonah and the Whale and Peter's vision of the sheet. Mass at St. Peter's Church. **Stop 2: Samaria-** Walk through the ancient ruins, have lunch and then visit Nablus, St. Jacob's Church - "**The Woman at the Well**", 4000 year-old **Jacob's well.** Opportunity to buy icons from world famous Fr Ioustinos **Stop 3:** Dinner and overnight at The Magdala Hotel.

Day 2, Wed. Sept 21- GALILEE

Stop 1: Cana: where Jesus performed His first miracle- water into wine! Renew marriage vows in the Church of Marriage. **Stop 2: Nazareth:** the **Basilica of the Annunciation**, built over where the Angel Gabriel appeared to Mary, **underground to archeological discoveries**, **St. Joseph's Church**, **Mary's Well**, and **synagogue** where Christ preached. **Stop 3: The Church of the Transfiguration**, sitting atop Mt. Tabor. **Stop 4:** Dinner and overnight The Magdala Hotel

Day 3, Thur, Sept 22- AROUND the SEA of GALILEE

Stop 1- Boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, Museum of the Boat ancient boat dating back over 2000 years. Stop 2: Capernaum: St. Peter's home- Jesus' home base for public ministry and the synagogue where Jesus proclaimed the Bread of Life Discourse. Stop 3: Mt. of Beatitudes, site of the Sermon on the Mount. Stop 4: Church of Tabgha--miracle of the multiplication of the fish and loaves, Stop 5: The Church of Primacy, where our Lord entrusted the care of the Church to St. Peter as the first Pope. Stop 6: Dinner and overnight at The Magdala Hotel.

Day 4, Fri, Sept 23-- The GOLAN HEIGHTS

Stop 1: Caesarea Philippi and the **archaeological site of Pan**. St Peter professed his belief in Jesus as the Son of God and then view spectacular waterfalls. **Stop 2: Kursi,** Where Jesus cast out the Legion of demons into a herd of swine. **Stop 3:** Lunch and archeological site of **Magdala** and the beautiful Duc in Altum Church. **Stop 4:** Free time (possible help with the dig). **Stop 5:** Dinner and overnight at The Magdala Hotel.

Day 5, Sat, Sept 24—ALONG THE MEDITERRANEAN to JERUSALEM!

Stop 1: Mt Carmel, and visit to the convent of Stella Maris and the Grotto of the Prophet Elijah. **Stop 2: Caesarea Maritime.** There you will visit one of the best-preserved hippodromes, amphitheater, and aqueducts in the world. **Stop 3: JERUSALEM!** Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Center.

Day 6, Sun, Sept 25—EIN KAREM and BETHLEHEM

Stop 1: Ein Karem and the **Church of the Visitation**, where the Virgin Mary met Elizabeth. **Stop 2: Church of St. John the Baptist. Stop 3: Bethlehem-the Basilica of the Nativity**, the **Chapel of St. Jerome, the Milk Grotto**, LUNCH in Bethlehem square and SHOPPING! **Stop 4: Shepherds Fields**. **Stop 5:** Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Center.

Day 7, Mon, Sept 26—JORDAN RIVER, JERICHO & the DEAD SEA

Stop 1: Renew Baptismal vows in the Jordan River where John Baptized Jesus. **Stop 2: Jericho**, the oldest and most continuously inhabited city in the world, cable car up to **the Mt of Temptations**. **Stop 3: Qumran.** Essene Monastery, the Dead Sea scrolls. **Stop 4:** LUNCH, MUD BATHS and SWIMMING in **the Dead Sea** at the Luxorious Isrotel Dead Sea Hotel. **Stop 5:** Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Center.

Day 8, Tues, Sept 27— JERUSALEM!

Stop 1: Dawn Mass (to be confirmed) at the Holy Sepulcher. Stop 2: After Mass, breakfast at the hotel. Stop 3: Walking tour of the Old City of Jerusalem. Stop 4: Temple Mount Area, the Western Wall, the Dome of the Rock, Al Aqsa Mosque, Archeological Tour of Tunnels under Western Wall Stop 5: St. Anne's Church, and Bethesda's Pool. Stop 6: Lunch, Stop 7: Via Dolorosa :the Flagellation Church, Ecce Homo, arriving at the Holy Sepulcher Stop 9: Bethany and the Tomb of Lazarus Stop 10: Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Center.


Day 9, Wed, Sept 28 -MT. of OLIVES

Lord wept over the city of Jerusalem. Stop 4: Garden and Church of Gethsemane, the site of the
Agony in the Garden. Stop 5: Mt. of Zion-the Church St. Peter in Gallicantu-where St. Peter denied
Jesus three times. Stop 6: The Cenacle, the site of the Last Supper Stop 7: Dormition AbbeyVirgin Mary's passing into eternal life. Stop 8: Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Center.

Day 10, Thur, Sept 29—EMMAUS & BEYOND...

Stop 1: the Benedictine Church of Emmaus-his disciples recognized him in the breaking of the Bread. **Stop 2:** Onwards those flying home will be taken to the airport, and those extending to Jordan will be transferred to the Allenby Bridge.

- Any and all last-minute flight cancellations and modifications.
- COVID treatment.
- Isolation costs: if a pilgrim fails a COVID test of those mentioned above, by law they will be forced to rent a twobedroom hotel room (in a designated COVID Hotel) or an apartment in town whilst they complete the mandatory isolation period.
- Lockdown costs if applicable.

CHILDREN UNDER 18: For a minor under the age of 18 to travel out of the United States without both parents or legal guardians, a notarized affidavit from the non-travelling parent(s) or guardian(s) must be obtained and presented upon departure and return to the United States.

STATE DEPARTMENT & OTHER AGENCIES: From time to time the State Department (www.state.gov) and the Center for Disease Control (www.cdc.gov) and other government agencies and departments issue travel advisories or warnings for one or more of the destinations that you may be visiting on tour. If an individual cancels between June 1 and July 31, a cancellation fee of \$500 will be applied. If an individual cancels after August 1, full cancellation fees will be applied.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ITINERARY: The Itinerary as presented in this brochure is tentative and represents what we are planning for you, however, it is subject to confirmations from many organizations. Because of changes in local schedules, we may need to alter specified events, dates and/or venues to better fit the overall plan. The right is reserved to alter or cancel the itinerary, at Via Emmaus sole discretion, as it may deem necessary or advisable.

ROOMS: Tour prices are per person according to a room type: a "Single" room is one person in a room and a "Double" is two persons in one room. Triples are one double bed with two persons sharing the bed and one single bed. Triples are not always available and are discouraged because of cramped quarters.

LUGGAGE: Baggage is at owner's risk throughout the tour.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Travelers must be medically and physically fit for this tour. This tour requires significant walking, as motor coaches are not permitted to pick up and drop off in front of major attractions. The tour is not wheelchair accessible and is not suitable for motorized scooters, walkers, and canes. Any special medical conditions or equipment must be advised in writing, for evaluation of feasibility, at the time of making your reservation. Should any special assistance be required, traveler agrees to bring a companion capable and willing to assist traveler.

COVID VACCINATION REQUIREMENT: At present, entry into Israel will require you to be vaccinated. Before boarding the plane, you will have to provide a negative PCR test, and be ready on arrival to perform a PCR and serology test upon the request of the Israeli authorities. All tests to be performed are on the pilgrim's own cost.
